All residents of Hopewell & Greenwich Townships who display a Convenience Center Pass are entitled to use the Shared Waste Facility located on Trench Road in Hopewell Township.

**Passes will be given to township residents only. There is a limit of 2 passes per household.**

### **\*\*ONLY HOUSEHOLD TRASH AND HOUSEHOLD RECYCLABLES WILL BE ACCEPTED\*\***

#### **DAYS AND HOURS OF OPERATION FOR THE CONVENIENCE CENTER ARE WEDNESDAY AND SATURDAY FROM 8:00AM TO 5:00PM**

1. **RECYCLABLES:** Please unload your own newspapers and recyclables while waiting in line and assist the attendants. Recycling of newspapers, food and beverage containers, oil, batteries, card board, computers, etc. saves the paying of expensive tipping fees. Trash is prohibited in the recycling containers. Please don't accumulate large trailer loads of trash. This causes unnecessary delays and is unsanitary. Red recyclable containers are available to **new** residents at the Hopewell Township Municipal Building.
2. **LEAVES** are composted and therefore must be removed from bags. Trash cannot be mixed in with leaves.
3. **BRUSH AND LIMBS OF 3FT. OR LESS** are to be neatly stacked so they can be run through the chipper. The chipped material is available for your use as mulch. **BRUSH DISPOSAL IS LIMITED TO ONE PICKUP LOAD PER DAY**, unless otherwise pre-approved by the Director of Public Works.
4. **LARGE ITEMS** must be placed in an open top large item container. Please pack them neatly so that space and money is not wasted.
5. **METAL** that can be recycled should be placed in the designated area. Cans, pesticides, tires, etc. are **not** allowed. They are collected by the County of Cumberland twice each year in the spring and fall.
6. **CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS** are **not** allowed. **ASBESTOS MATERIALS** are **not** allowed. The County Solid Waste Complex off of Sherman Avenue in Vineland will accept these materials for a weight fee. They are open 7:30am to 3:00pm Monday through Friday and 8:00am to 12:00pm on Saturday.
7. Large 55 gallon barrels are a safety hazard and will not be unloaded by employees. Please keep your trash as dry as possible and packed in strong medium size bags such as the 30 gallon size.
8. Please use closed bags and containers when transporting trash to the convenience center. If you have an open bed truck or trailer, please use a tarp.
9. We will accept appliances and white goods. They must be unloaded where designated. **Do not remove the refrigerant!**
